



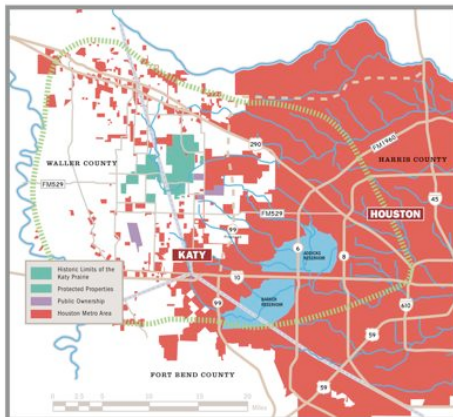

**Description:** Assist in greeting guests at *Open Trails*; offer educational handouts and brief instructions.

**Where:** KPC Field Office and other KPC Preserves

**When:** Friday mornings & 1st Sunday of every month

**Who:** Individuals and groups.

**Time commitment:** Weekly sessions of 3-4 hours. Volunteers can work as many or as few sessions as they choose.

**Physical requirements:** Volunteers must sit and stand outdoors for extended periods (chairs & shade provided). Some bending and light lifting required.

**Experience/Knowledge:** None required

**Training:** Available during week days or at session. Contact [info@katyprairie.org](mailto:info@katyprairie.org) to arrange a training session

**What to wear:** Comfortable clothing including long pants and a hat.

**Volunteer benefits:** Open Trails Greeters are invited to attend *EConnections* classes and other volunteer events.
