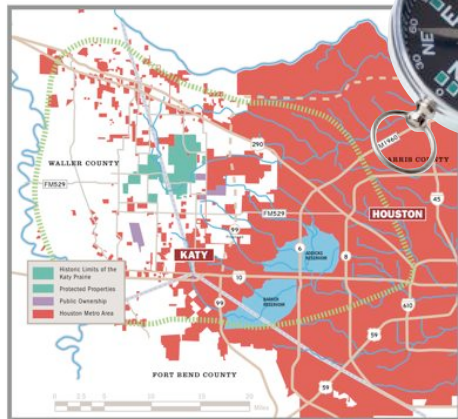

## Prairie Discovery Tour Guide

Become a great storyteller!

**Description:** Lead themed tours for groups of 5 to 15 on a pre-determined route.

**Where:** Various KPC Preserves

**When:** Bimonthly Saturday mornings or evenings.

**Who:** Individuals

**Time commitment:** 4 hours every other month. Tour guides may lead between two and six tours per year.

**Physical requirements:** Walking long distances. Ability to perform environmental education activities (e.g. pond dipping and sweep netting of insects).

**Experience/Knowledge:** A basic knowledge of ecology, KPC's mission and methods, and Katy Prairie history (see special opportunities below).

**Training:** (1) Complete three *EConnections* courses and (2) Shadow an experienced KPC guide once before leading a tour

**What to wear:** Comfortable outdoor clothing, including long pants and a hat.

**Volunteer benefits:** Tour guides are provided free training (through the *EConnections* program) in basic ecology, history, and conservation finance.

The Katy Prairie Conservancy (KPC) is a private non-profit organization dedicated to saving a sustainable portion of the *Flat Out Wonderful* Katy Prairie located just west of Houston.

KPC has protected over 13,000 acres (teal in map above) since 1996.
