Collect Seeds

Volunteers collect seeds in late summer through fall at local prairies.



2

Attend a Seed Packing Party

Seed packing parties are held where we typically pack 2,000 seed packets per party.

Distribute Seeds

Volunteer growers pick up seeds from the CPC Field Office, CPC Houston Office, and special events listed on our website.



4

Grow Seeds at Home or School

Volunteers grow plants at home or at school for several months using online instructions.



5

Return Plants

Volunteers return plants when the roots of their plants are starting to poke out of their four-inch pots or one-gallon pots.

6

Participate in a Planting Day!

Volunteers are invited to join in a big planting day at a preserve, public park, or local school.
